About

- Charak Ayurvedic Pharmacy, Paprola was started in the Year 1997 with the assistance from Government of India in a single story building having 1600 Sq. Ft. covered area.
- Later on a project was submitted to the Government of India for further strengthening of the Pharmacy which was sanctioned by the Government of India.
- The new pharmacy building which was constructed by the Govt. became functional in the year 2008. In the year 2017 additional bhatti section was constructed for preparation of various ayurvedic formulations.





- A drying shed for drying of raw herbs and a godown for storage of the medicines was added to the above infrastructure in the year 2021.
- The Charak Govt. Ayurvedic pharmacy, Paprola has approval for different sections like Tablets, Churan (Powders), Liquid section (Syp., Oil, Ghrita etc) and is having section for Qwath, Awaleha, Capsule, Vati, Lepa and Bhasamas etc.



Present activities of the pharmacy:-

Govt. Ayurvedic Pharmacy, Paprola is presently engaged in the following activities.

1. U.G. Practicals —

60-80 practicals are conducted every year in this pharmacy for the students of B.A.M.S. IInd prof.

2. P.G. Practicals :-

About 180- 200 practicals are conducted every year in this pharmacy for the students of B.A.M.S and P.G students of ras shastra and bhaishjya kalpana.

3. Research drug manufacturing:-

This is the another important activity of the pharmacy in which P.G. research drug for the scholars of different departments are manufactured in this pharmacy under the guidance and supervision of experts of the subjects and these drugs are also analyzed from DTL Jogindernagar and some other laboratories. About 110 research drugs are manufactured every year in this pharmacy.

4. Annual target :-

The Pharmacy has been assigned to manufacture annual medicine supply for 1255 Ayurvedic Health Centers and 25 hospitals in Himachal Pradesh for which budget is allotted by Directorate of AYUSH, Govt. of H.P. Annual target of different medicine was completed in given time duration along with manufacturing of different research drugs and U.G / P.G. practicals of Rajiv Gandhi govt. Post Graduate Ayurvedic College Paprola.

Review Meeting Response: Production and Improvement at Charak Govt. Ayu. Pharmacy Paprola.

1.Production Efficiency:

Current Status: The pharmacy has increased its production output by 10% over the last quarter due to optimized resource allocation and improved equipment maintenance.

Action Points: Continue monitoring production processes and address any bottlenecks. Invest in newer technologies to further streamline operations. New automatic furnances are made functional for research work. New volcanic pulverizer is also made functional which results in the double the grinding rate with minimum man power. New skilled man power through outsource is appointed.

2.Quality Control:

Current Status: Several improvements in quality control were implemented, including stricter checks on raw material sourcing and more frequent testing of batches.

Action Points: Further enhancement of quality control by introducing S.O.P and training for quality checks to reduce human error. Implement additional training for staff on GMP (Good Manufacturing Practices) guidelines.

5.New Product Development:


- •Current Status: A couple of new formulations are under research and development, focusing on demand for immunity-boosting products.
- •Action Points: Fast-track the development of new formulations and explore collaborations with research institutes like C.I.S.R to innovate further. Pharmacy recently got two approval for new proprietary •products-1.Shoolari balm and 2.Dizoboost tablet.

6.Workforce Training and Development:

- •Current Status: The pharmacy conducted periodic training sessions for workers.
- •Action Points: Additional skill development programs should be introduced to upskill employees in new technology and techniques in Ayurvedic medicine production.

7. Sustainability and Waste Management:

Current Status: The pharmacy has made improvements in waste management by reducing water waste and Manure making from waste by product like debries of kwath etc. and utilising further for college herbal garden.

Action Points: minimize the environmental impact of the production process. The big pit was constructed to decompose waste received after production.

Management Of Biomedical Waste

- Most of the waste generated in our pharmacy is of herbal origin
- Solid herbal waste generated is disposed in pits for manure formation, which is further utilized in herbal garden located in college campus
- Liquid waste is disposed into soak pits which are connected to a primary treatment unit.
