Short title & Commencement: 1 (1) These rules may be called the Himachal Pradesh Department of Ayurveda, Ayurvedic Pharmacist, Class-III (Non-Gazetted) Recruitment & Promotion Rules, 2013

(2) These rules shall come into force from the date of publication in official Gazette.

n Repeal & Savings:

2 (1) The Himachal Pradesh Ayurveda Department (Indian System of Medicine & Homeopathy) Ayurvedic Pharmacist Class-III (Non Gazetted) (Non-Ministrial Services) Recruitment & Promotion Rules, 2009 notified vide this Department's Notification No. Ayur-Ka (3)-5/97 dated 26-8-2009 are hereby repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, any appointment made or anything done or any action taken under the relevant rules so repealed under sub rule (1) supra shall be deemed to have been validly made, done or taken under these rules.

10. Method(s) of recruitment, whether by direct recruitment or by promotion, deputation, transfer and the percentage of post (s) to be filled in by various methods:

11. In case of recruitment by promotion, deputation, transfer, grade from which promotion/ deputation/ transfer is to be made:

By promotion from amongst the Trained Dai Subject to possessing of educational qualification prescribed for direct recruitment against Column No.7(a) above with five years regular service or regular combined with continuous adhoc service, if any, in the grade.

Provided that for the purpose of promotion a combined seniority list of eligible Trained Dai on the basis of length of service in the respective grade without disturbing their cadre-wise seniority shall be prepared.

Note: The roster will be repeated after every 100th point till the representation to both categories is achieved by the given percentage and thereafter the vacancy shall be filled up from the category which vacates the post.

Provided that for the purpose of promotion every employee shall have to serve at least one term in the Tribal/Difficult areas subject to adequate number of post(s) available in such areas.

Provided further that the proviso (I) supra shall not be applicable in the case of those employees who have five years or less services, left for superannuation.

Provided further that Officers/Officials who have not served atleast one tenure in Tribal/Difficult area shall be transferred to such area strictly in accordance with his/her seniority in the respective cadre.

Explanation-I:- For the purpose of proviso I supra the "term" in Tribal / Difficult areas" shall mean normally three years or less period of posting in such areas keeping in view the administrative requirements and performance of the employee.

- 9 Khanyol-Bagra Patwar Circle of Karsog Tehsil Gada-Gussaini, Mathyani, Ghanyar, Thachi Baggi, Somgad and Kholanal of Bali-Chowki Sub Tehsil, Jharwar, Kutgarh, Graman, Devgarh, trailla, Ropa, Kathog, Silh-Badhwani, Hastpur, Ghamrehar and Bhatehar patwar Circle of Padhar Tehsil, Chiuni, Kalipar, Mangarh, Thach-Bagra, North Magru and South

Magru Patwar Circles of Thunag Tehsil and Batwara Patwar Circle of Sunder Nagar Tehsil in Mandi District.

(Y) In all cases of promotion, the continuous adhoc service rendered in the feeder post, if any, prior to regular appointment to the post shall be taken into account towards the length of service as prescribed in these rules for promotion subject to the condition that the adhoc appointment/promotion in the feeder category had been made after following proper acceptable process of selection in accordance with the provisions of R&P Rules;

Provided that in all cases where a junior person becomes eligible for consideration by virtue of his/her total length of service (including the service rendered on adhoc basis, followed by regular service/appointment) in the feeder post in view of the provision referred to above, all persons senior to him/her in the respective category/post/cadre shall be deemed to be eligible for consideration and placed above the junior person in the field of consideration;

Provided that all incumbents to be considered for promotion shall possess the minimum qualifying service of at least three years' or that prescribed in the R&P Rules for the post, whichever is less;

Provided further that where a person becomes ineligible to be considered for promotion on account of the requirements of the preceding proviso, the person(s) junior to him/her shall also be deemed to be ineligible for consideration for such promotion;

EXPLANATION:- The last proviso shall not render the junior incumbent(s) ineligible for consideration for promotion if the senior ineligible person(s) happened to be Ex-servicemen recruited under the provisions of Rule-3 of the Demobilized Armed Forces Personnel (Reservation of Vacancies in Himachal State Non-Technical Services) Rules, 1972 and having been given the benefit of seniority there-under or recruited under the provisions of Rule-3 of the Ex-servicemen(Reservation of Vacancies in the Himachal Pradesh Technical Services) Rules, 1985 and having been given the benefit of seniority there-under.

	<p>(2) Similarly, in all cases of confirmation, adhoc service rendered on the feeder post, if any, prior to the regular appointment against such post shall be taken into account towards the length of service, if the adhoc appointment/promotion had been made after proper selection and in accordance with the provision of the R&P Rules.</p> <p>Provided that inter-se-seniority as a result of confirmation after taking into account, adhoc service rendered as referred to above shall remain unchanged.</p>	
12.	If a Departmental Promotion committee exists, what is its composition?	As may be constituted by the Govt. from time to time.

15-A	Selection for appointment to the post by contract appointment.	Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, contract appointments to the post will be made subject to the terms and conditions given below:-

I) Concept:

- (a) Under this policy the Ayurvedic Pharmacist, in the Department of Ayurveda, H.P. will be engaged on contract basis initially for one year, which may be extendable on year to year basis.

Provided that for extension/ renewal of contract period on year to year basis the concerned HOD shall issue a certificate that the service and conduct of the contract appointee is satisfactory during the year and only then his period of contract is to be renewed/ extended.

b) Posts falls within the purview of H.P.S.S.S.B :

The Director of Ayurveda, after obtaining the approval of the Government to fill up the vacant posts on contract basis will place the requisition with the concerned recruiting agency i.e. H.P. Subordinate Services Selection Board, Hamirpur.

- (C) The selection will be made in accordance with the eligibility condition prescribed in these R&P Rules.

II) Contractual Emoluments :

The Ayurvedic Pharmacist, appointed on contract basis will be paid consolidated fixed contractual amount @ ₹ 8,910/- per month (which shall be equal to minimum of the pay band + grade pay). An amount of ₹ 267/- (3% of the minimum of pay band+ grade pay of the post) as annual increase in contractual emoluments for the subsequent year(s) will be allowed if contract is extended beyond one year.

III) Appointing/Disciplinary Authority:

The Director, of Ayurveda H.P. will be appointing and disciplinary authority.

IV) Selection Process :

Selection for appointment to the post in the case of contract appointment will be made on the basis of viva-voce test, or if considered necessary or expedient by a written test or practical test, the standard /syllabus etc. of which will be determined by the concerned recruitment agency i.e. H.P Subordinate Services Selection Board, Hamirpur.

V) Committee for selection of Contractual Appointments:-

As may be constituted by the concerned recruiting agency i.e. H.P Subordinate Services Selection Board, Hamirpur from time to time.

VI) Agreement :-

After selection of a candidate, he/she shall sign an agreement as per Annexure-"B" appended to these Rules.

VII) Terms and Conditions :-

- (a) The contract appointee will be paid fixed contractual amount @ ₹ 8,910/- per month (which shall be equal to minimum of the pay band + grade pay). The contract appointee will be entitled for increase in contractual amount @Rs. 267/-(3% of the minimum of pay band+ grade pay of the post) for further extended years and no other allied benefits such as senior/selection scales etc. will be given.
- b) The service of the contract appointee will be purely on temporary basis. The appointment is liable to be terminated in case the performance/ conduct of the contract appointee is not found satisfactory.
- c) Contract appointee will be entitled for one day's casual leave after putting one month service. However the contract employee will also be entitled for 12 weeks Maternity leave and 10 days Medical Leave. He/She shall not be entitled for Medical Re-imburement and

LTC etc. No leave of any other kind except above is admissible to the contract appointee.

Provided that the un-availed Casual Leave and Medical Leave can be accumulated upto the calendar year and will not be carried forward for the next calendar year.

- d) Unauthorized absence from the duty without the approval of the controlling Officer shall automatically lead to the termination of the contract. Contract appointee shall not be entitled for contractual amount for the period of absence from duty.
- e) An official appointed on contract basis who has completed three years tenure at one place of posting will be eligible for transfer on need based basis wherever required on administrative grounds.
- f) Selected candidate will have to submit a certificate of his/her fitness from a Government/ Registered Medical Practitioner. The women candidate pregnant beyond 12 weeks will stand temporarily unfit till the confinement is over. The women candidate will be re-examined for the fitness from an authorized Medical officer/Practitioner.
- g) Contract appointee will be entitled to TA / DA if required to go on tour in connection with his/her official duty at the same rate as applicable to regular counterpart officials at the minimum of pay scale.
- h) Provisions of service rules like FR,SR, Leave Rules, GPF Rules, Pension Rules & Conduct Rules etc. as are applicable in case of regular employees will not be applicable in case of contract appointees. They will be entitled for emoluments etc. as detailed in this Column.

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16.	Reservation:	The appointment to the services shall be subject to orders regarding reservation in the service for Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes /Other Backward Classes /Other categories of persons issued by the Himachal Pradesh Government from time to time.
17.	Departmental Examination	Not applicable .
18.	Power to relax:	Where the State Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Himachal Pradesh Public Services Commission relax any of the provision(s) of these rules with respect to any class or category of person(s) or post(s).

Annexure-B

Form of contract/agreement to be executed between the Ayurvedic Pharmacist and the Government of Himachal Pradesh through the Director Ayurveda.

This agreement is made on this -----day of ----- in the year----- between Shri/Smt.-----R/O-----contract appointee (hereinafter called the First Party) AND the Governor, Himachal Pradesh through Director Ayurveda, Himachal Pradesh (herein after called the SECOND PARTY).

Whereas, the SECOND PARTY has engaged the aforesaid FIRST PARTY and the FIRST PARTY has agreed to serve as a Ayurvedic Pharmacist on contract basis on the following terms & conditions:-

1. That the FIRST PARTY shall remain in the service of the SECOND PARTY as a Ayurvedic Pharmacist for a period of one year commencing on -----day of -----and ending on the -----day of -----. It is specifically mentioned and agreed upon by both the parties that the contract of the FIRST PARTY with SECOND PARTY shall post- ipso facto stand terminated on the last working day i.e. on ----- and information notice shall not be necessary.

h Provided that for further extension/renewal of contract period the HOD shall issue a certificate that the service and conduct of the contract appointee was satisfactory during the year and only then his period of contract is to be renewed / extended.

2. The contractual amount of the FIRST PARTY will be ₹.8,910/- per month.

3. The service of FIRST PARTY will be purely on temporary basis. The appointment is liable to be terminated in case the performance /conduct of the contract appointee is not found good or if a regular incumbent is appointed/posted against the vacancy for which the first party was engaged on contract.

4. Contractual Ayurvedic Pharmacist will be entitled for one day casual leave after putting in one month service. However, the contract employee will also be entitled for 12 weeks maternity Leave and 10 day's Medical Leave. He /She not be entitled for Medical Re-imburement and LTC etc. No leave of any other kind except above is admissible to the contractual Ayurvedic Pharmacist.

Provided that the un-availed Casual Leave and Medicial Leave can be accumulated upto the calendar year and will not be carried forward for the next Calender year.

5. Unauthorized absence from duty without the approval of the controlling officer shall automatically lead to the termination of the contract. A contractual Ayurvedic Pharmacist will not be entitled for contractual amount for the period of absence from duty.

6. An official appointed on contract basis who have completed three years tenure at on place of posting will be eligible for transfer on need based basis wherever required on administrative grounds.

7. Selected candidate will have to submit a certificate of his/her fitness from a Government /Registered Medical Practioner. In case of Women candidate pregnant beyond twelve weeks will render her temporarily unfit till the confinement is over. The women candidate will be re- examined for the fitness from an authorized Medical Officer/practitioner.

8. Contract appointee shall be entitled for TA/DA if required to go on tour in connection with his/her official duty at the same rate as applicable to regular counter part official at the minimum of pay scale.

9. The Employees Group Insurance Scheme as well as EPF/GPF will not be applicable to contractual appointee(s).

1972 and having been given the benefit of seniority there-under or recruited under the provisions of Rule-3 of the Ex-servicemen(Reservation of Vacancies in the Himachal Pradesh Technical Services) Rules, 1985 and having been given the benefit of seniority there-under.

(2) Similarly, in all cases of confirmation, adhoc service rendered on the feeder post, if any, prior to the regular appointment against such post shall be taken into account towards the length of service, if the adhoc appointment/promotion had been made after proper selection and in accordance with the provision of the R&P Rules.

Provided that inter-se-seniority as a result of confirmation after taking into account, adhoc service rendered as referred to above shall remain unchanged."
